Registration and Enrollment:

- **Current Grace Families** - If you have re-enrolled your child in Gradelink for the coming school year, your first step is complete. Sign and return this form via email to djackson@gracelcms.net.
 - If your child is currently attending Grace but they will not be attending for the new school year, please re-enroll them in Gradelink but **choose SUMMER for their grade.**
- **If your child doesn't attend Grace, but has attended Grace previously** - email the school at djackson@gracelcms.net so that we can reactivate your school account. Once your child has been reactivated, re-enroll them in Gradelink choosing **SUMMER** as their grade. Sign this form and return this form via email to djackson@gracelcms.net.
- **If you are new to Grace** - please go to our website at www.graceschoolescondido.org and click on the admissions tab, then Elementary/Middle School/K-8 Enrollment Process, then New Student Gradelink and complete the enrollment for Summer Childcare. When choosing your child's grade make sure to select **SUMMER**. This also serves as your child's emergency contact form. Sign this form and return to djackson@gracelcms.net.

Weekly Summer Childcare Rate: \$250.00 per week.

*Payment must be made and your child's space reserved on THURSDAY of the previous week.

Due to current regulations, we must know the exact students who will be attending to comply with health requirements that students are kept in stable groups. This rate is guaranteed through June 26th, 2020. Grace Christian School reserves the right to adjust the rate at that time should expenses associated with Summer Childcare vary significantly. We will be reevaluating the program weekly based on new guidelines.

Covid-19 Measures:

In response to the Covid-19 pandemic, the following measures will be in place:

- Students will be kept in separate, stable groups of 12 or fewer with the same primary childcare provider.
- Social distancing, healthy hygiene and intense cleaning, sanitation and disinfecting will be practiced.
- All students and staff will undergo a health screening daily before being admitted into the facility.
- No one with a temperature of 100 degrees or above will be admitted.
- Visitors will not be allowed to enter the facility.

Late Pick-up Fees Policy:

Fees for pick-up after 6:00pm will be charged as follows:

- 6:01pm to 6:15pm, billed at 1:00 per minute (for the first 15 minutes late)
- 6:16pm and on, billed at \$5.00 per minute (with no limit)

Medication:

It is understood that Grace will administer medication per the medication policy that is outlined in the Family Handbook which can be found on the Grace Christian School website.

Dress Code:

Summer Childcare dress code will follow the “Free Dress” guidelines in the school dress code. This is outlined in the Family Handbook. Bathing suits must be moderate, please wear a t-shirt and shorts over bathing suits while not participating in water activities. The safety of your children is important; the summer childcare policy is to have closed toed shoes while on campus. Shoe guidelines are in effect all day everyday. The only exception is when there are water activities planned for the day, students may wear sandals or water shoes for water activities. For safety reasons, shoes must be worn at all times.

Phone Policy:

Students are discouraged from phone use during Summer Childcare. If you need to speak with your student, please call Grace directly. Student requests for phone use will be screened and the conversation will be monitored. Students are to make arrangements to go to friend’s homes before they arrive at Grace. Please remember to update your contact numbers if they have changed.

Bicycles, Skateboards and Scooters:

These items are allowed during Summer Childcare. They may only be used on the blacktop with staff supervision. Helmets must be worn at all times and cannot be shared. Ramps, rail sliding, curbing, riding on stairs and jumping will not be allowed. Rules will be strictly enforced. It is your child’s responsibility if these items are lost or broken.

Electronics:

Electronic games (iPads, tablets, personal game devices) may be brought from home and should be labeled with your child’s name. These items will not be shared. Electronics brought from home may only be used by the student who brought the device. Students are responsible for bringing their own chargers. They may not play games that use guns, other weapons, or inappropriate activities. Students may not view video content that is of an inappropriate nature. All electronics will be used at the discretion of the Summer Childcare staff, and will be limited to use while indoors only. Please remember it is your child’s responsibility if these items get lost or broken.

Toys:

Toys may be brought from home with the exception of those that resemble guns or other weapons. Toys will not be shared and should have your child’s name on them. Again, it is your child’s responsibility if these items get lost or broken.
