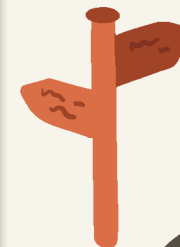

Registration and Enrollment:

- **Current Grace Families** - If you have re-enrolled your child in Gradelink for the coming school year, your first step is complete. Sign and return this form with the one-time enrollment fee.
 - If your child is currently attending Grace but will not be attending for the new school year, please re-enroll them in Gradelink but **choose SUMMER for their grade.**
- **If your child doesn't currently attend Grace but has attended Grace previously** - email the school at djackson@gracelems.net so that we can reactivate your school account. Once your child has been reactivated, re-enroll them in Gradelink choosing **SUMMER** as their grade. Sign this form and return it with the enrollment fee to the school office. Or, slip it in the mail slot to the right of the school office.
- **If you are new to Grace** - please go to our website at www.graceschoolscondido.org and click on the "Enroll Now" button, then New Student Gradelink and complete the enrollment for Summer Camp. When choosing your child's grade make sure to select **SUMMER**. This also serves as your child's emergency contact form. Sign this form and return it with the enrollment fee to the school office. Or, if outside of school office hours, slip it in the mail slot to the right of the school office door.

Summer Camp Rates:

ENROLLMENT: \$55.00 per child.

FULL DAY: \$65.00 per day or \$325.00 per week.

HALF DAY: \$50.00 per day or \$250.00 per week (6:30 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.)

FIELD TRIP FEE: See Schedule.

***Field trip payment must be made and your child's space reserved on THURSDAY of the previous week.**

***All on campus field trips are mandatory for students attending on the date scheduled.**

Late Pick-up Fees Policy:

Fees for pick-up after 6:00pm will be charged as follows:

- 6:01pm to 6:15pm, billed at \$1.00 per minute (for the first 15 minutes late)
- 6:16pm and on, billed at \$5.00 per minute (with no limit)

Medication:

It is understood that Grace will administer medication per the medication policy that is outlined in the Family Handbook which can be found on the Grace Christian School website by clicking the myGCS button.

Dress Code:

Summer Camp dress code will follow the “Free Dress” guidelines in the school dress code. This is outlined in the Family Handbook. Bathing suits must provide moderate coverage. T-shirt and shorts or coverup must be worn over bathing suits when children are not participating in water activities. The safety of your children is important; the Summer Camp policy is to have closed-toed shoes while on campus. Shoe guidelines are in effect all day every day. The only exception is when there are water activities planned for the day, students may wear sandals or water shoes for water activities. For safety reasons, shoes must be worn at all times.

Phone Policy:

Children are not allowed to use cell phones during Summer Camp. Please call Grace if you need to connect with your student.

Bicycles, Skateboards, and Scooters:

These items are allowed during Summer Camp. They may only be used on the blacktop with staff supervision. Helmets must be worn at all times and cannot be shared. Ramps, rail sliding, curbing, riding on stairs and jumping will not be allowed. Rules will be strictly enforced. It is your child’s responsibility if these items are lost or broken.

Electronics:

Electronic games (iPads, tablets, personal game devices) may be brought from home and should be labeled with your child’s name. These items will not be shared. Electronics brought from home may only be used by the student who brought the device. Students are responsible for bringing their own chargers. They may not play games that use guns, other weapons, or inappropriate activities. Students may not view video content that is of an inappropriate nature. All electronics will be used at the discretion of the Summer Camp staff and will be limited to use while indoors only. Please remember it is your child’s responsibility to take care of their devices. Grace will not be held responsible for damage to or loss of these items.

Toys:

Toys may be brought from home with the exception of those that resemble guns or other weapons. Toys will not be shared and should be labeled with your child’s name. Grace will not be responsible for damage to or loss of toys.

Sunscreen will be applied before going outside or to an outing. Sunscreen will then be reapplied as necessary after the first application. It **is my responsibility to provide sunscreen with an SPF of 30 or higher.** If my child does not have sunscreen provided, summer camp staff may apply sunscreen that they have on hand with an SPF of 30 or higher. Sunscreen will be re-applied as necessary throughout the day.

_____ I give Grace Summer Camp staff permission to apply sunscreen when my child goes outside or on an outing. Summer Camp staff may assist in reapplying sunscreen as needed.
